WATER AND SEWER

INVOLUNTARY TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICE RIGHTS

Reasons for Termination of Service:

- 1) A customer's water service may be terminated for any of the following reasons:
 - a. Failure of the customer, or occupant, to pay all charges for water service within thirty (30) days after such charges are billed. Such charges shall include, but not be limited to:
 - i. the Service Availability Fee;
 - ii. estimated charges for water usage;
 - iii. charges for actual usage;
 - iv. late charges (a charge equal to 10% of the delinquent bill shall automatically be assessed if the bill is not paid within ten (20) days of the billing date);
 - v. any charges for damage by the customer, or occupant, to any of College Corner Water and Sewer's equipment;
 - vi. any charges for maintenance to the customer's equipment which College Corner Water and Sewer might perform or have performed by others at the customer's request;
 - vii. any other delinquent charges from the customer's existing service, or any prior service, connection on the College Corner Water and Sewer system; and
 - viii. any other charges which are contained upon the customer's bill.
 - b. Unauthorized use by the customer, or occupant, of the College Corner Water and Sewer system including, but not limited to:
 - i. Use of water without payment of the required connection charges;
 - ii. Tampering with, or alteration of, the water metering device installed, and owned, by the District.
- 2) In addition to, or in lieu of, termination of the water service, College Corner Water and Sewer may charge the Owner of the property the charges described in the College Corner Water and Sewer regulation titled Unauthorized Use of Water. Any applicable reconnection and reinstatement fees shall also apply.
- 3) The customer's failure to comply with the College Corner Water and Sewer policy prohibiting cross connections between the public water system and any private water supply.
- 4) The customer's failure to comply with the College Corner Water and Sewer policy regarding backflow prevention.
