**Mike reported that Indiana INDOT will move the cross walk on US 27 by Mound Street North due to the Railroad being to close to the present walk.**


**Emily Bourne asked about the police contract with Butler County for the town police officer.**


**Ohio council said they were working on it?**


**Emily reported she has talked with the Butler County Sheriff's office and they said there would not be an officer from Butler County here on the Indiana side of town.**
