B. Approval of Minutes/Bill

C. New Business/ Old Business/Continual Reports

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Ruther moved to approve Resolution 2022 P- Butler County SLRF Grant for Preble, Butler and Franklin Streets. Mr. Bake seconded the motion. Vote: 5:0 in favor. Motion carried.

Mr. Bake moved to approve Resolution 2022 Q- Accepting the Amounts and Rates as Determined by the Budget Commission. Mr. Ruther seconded the motion. Vote: 4:1 in favor. Motion carried. Mr. Toothman abstained.

Ordinance 2022 C was read entirely by Mayor Jackson. The ordinance is to allow Charter to up the percentage the Village receives from 3% to 5%.

Ordinance 2022 B was read by the title by Mr. Hankins. The ordinance is to allow the operation of golf carts in the Village.

Old Business
