Property Updates- Mr. Bake thanked Emery Persinger and Sheldon Lackey for taking care of 200 Monfort Street.


Street Commissioner- the street paint project has been completed. Discussed how to handle parking on County Line Street. Discuss painting yellow or putting more no parking signs up.
