A. Agenda

B. Approval of Minutes/Bills

Mr. Bake moved to approve the minutes for the regular meeting on March 14, 2024 as presented. Mr. Cedar seconded the motion. Vote: 5: 1 in favor. Motion carried. Ms. Bolser voted no. Mr. Bake moved to approve the bills for March 2024. Mr. Ruther seconded the motion. Vote: 4:2 in favor. Ms. Bolser and Ms. McCoy voted no. Motion carried.

C. New Business/ Old Business/Continual Reports

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Cason read the title of Resolution 2024 E, Resolution to Proceed- with Election on the Question of a Renewal Tax in Excess of the Ten-Mill Limitation. Mr. Bake moved to approve and adopt Resolution 2024 E. Mr. Ruther seconded the motion. Vote: 6:0 in favor. Motion carried.

Resolution 2024 F, Rules of Council. There will be a change in #10 the second sentence and on the agenda for next month.

Resolution 2024 G, Butler County Solid Waste. This resolution will be tabled.

Old Business

Mr. Conover prepared the notice of violation and Mr. Cedar will begin using it.

Continual Reports

Property Updates- Mr. Cedar reported that Roger Bowling owns the property next to 301 Main Street and pictures of 301 Main Street were shared with Council. Mayor Cason called the attorney on the case and the attorney never answered the call. She might have been calling the wrong attorney.

Planning Commission- Ms. Cason reported she has appointed Justin Singleton and Shelley Ratliff to the Planning Commission for the residential requirements. Ann McCoy will be the representative from the Council.

Village Administrator- no updates other than went to Eaton to present the CDBG project.



Adjournment


