Council Meeting Minutes

May 9, 2024

**Opening:**

The regular meeting of the Council of the Village of College Corner, Ohio was called to order at 8:30 a.m. on May 9, 2024.

**Present:**

Roll Call: William Bake, Wes Cedar, Mike Ruther, Ann McCoy, Danyell Bolser, and Brian Toothman.

**A. Agenda**

There was an agenda distributed prior to the meeting.

**Executive Session**

Mr. Bake moved to enter executive session pursuant to ORC 121.22 (G)(1) to discuss the employment of a public employee. Mr. Cedar seconded the motion. Vote: 4:2 in favor. Ms. Bolser and Ms. McCoy voted no. Motion carried. Time entered executive session was 8:31 a.m.

The regular meeting was reconvened at 9:05 a.m. and all members of council were present. Mr. Toothman moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Cedar seconded the motion. Vote: 4:2 against. Motion failed. Mr. Toothman and Mr. Cedar voted yes. Mr. Toothman exited the meeting.

**B. Approval of Minutes/Bills**

Mr. Ruther moved to approve the minutes for the regular meeting on April 11, 2024, as presented. Mr. Bake seconded the motion. Vote: 3:2 in favor. Motion carried. Ms. Bolser and Ms. McCoy voted no.

Mr. Bake moved to approve the bills for April 2024. Mr. Ruther seconded the motion. Vote: 3:2 in favor. Motion carried. Ms. Bolser and Ms. McCoy voted no.

A request by council was made to have actual bills with the list of bills at the meetings.

**New Business/Old Business/Continual Reports**

Mr. Conover reported that he will have the Rules of Council prepared for council action at the June regular council meeting.

Ms. Bolser moved to add the mayor as a signer to the Village's bank account. Ms. McCoy seconded the motion. Vote: 4:1 in favor. Motion carried. Mr. Cedar voted no.

Ms. Bolser moved to schedule future council meetings during the evenings. Ms. McCoy seconded the motion. Vote: 3:2 in favor. Motion carried. Mr. Bake and Mr. Cedar voted no.

Concerns about future EMS service to Israel Township residents inside the corporate boundaries of the Village was discussed. A suggestion was made to meet with the Israel Township Trustees to get firsthand information about future EMS services.

A special council meeting was set for May 22, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at the Village Chambers to:

1. discuss the future council meeting dates and times.
2. consider the employment of a public employee.


### **Public Participation**


