Opening: The emergency meeting of council was called to order at 7:00pm on July 3rd, 2024

Molly read a letter that was presented to her from Byrco.

Ms. Mccoy seconded the motion. Vote 2:1 in favor, motion carried, Mr. Ruther voted no.

Discussion of reviewing the applications for the posted jobs, Mr. Ruther stated he would assist with the interview/hiring process, Ms. Bolser offered assistance as well.

Ms. Bolser said she could have her husband cut the grass until someone could be hired, Mr. Ruther stated that we would need to add him to the insurance policy first.

Ms. Bolser made a motion to proceed with hiring Nicholas J. Ziepfel as village solicitor, Ms. Mccoy seconded the motion. Vote 3:0 in favor, Motion carried.

Emily Bourne from Indiana voiced her concerns about being paid and having contractors.


Several people have offered their support during the changes.

Adjournment:


Ms. Bolser made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:58PM, Ms. Mccoy seconded the motion. Vote 3:0 in favor
