

Village of College Corner, Ohio
Council meeting minutes
July 11th, 2024

Opening:

The regular meeting of the Council of the Village Of College Corner, Ohio was called to order at 7:00pm on July 11th, 2024.

Present:

Roll Call: Ann McCoy, Danyell Bolser, Mike Ruther.

Others: Molly Cason, Nick Ziepfel

Agenda: The agenda was distributed prior to the meeting.

Ms. Cason read Brian Toothman's resignation letter. Ms. Bolser moved to appoint Tom Caudill and Brandi Singleton to the open council seats. Ms McCoy seconded, vote 3:0 in favor. Motion carried. Oath of office will take place before the next regular meeting.

Approval of minutes/bills:

Ms. Bolser moved to approve minutes for the regular June 13th meeting as presented, Ms. McCoy seconded the motion. Vote 2:1 in favor, Ms. Bolser and Ms McCoy voted yes, Mr. Ruther abstained. Motion carried. Ms. Bolser moved to approve the special meeting minutes for June 25th. Ms. McCoy seconded the motion, vote 2:1 in favor. Motion carried. Ms. Bolser and Ms. McCoy voted yes, Mr. Ruther abstained. Ms. Bolser moved to approve the emergency July 3rd minutes, Ms. McCoy seconded vote 3:0 in favor. Motion carried. Ms. Bolser moved to approve the bills from May, Ms. McCoy seconded, vote 3:0 in favor. Motion carried.

New Business:

All property has not been returned from the fiscal officer, Ms. Cason read off a list of items that were returned, but it is noted that items are still missing.

Police contract renewal is in process with BCSO and an update will be provided at the next meeting.

Job postings were on the website and social media, the interviews will begin next week.

A question of some not receiving their water bills, Ms. Cason is looking into the reason, and is working diligently to make sure everyone's issues were resolved.

Attorney contract: Ms. Bolser asked if a 30 day notice from both parties could be added to the contract. Mr. Ziepfel said absolutely and would send an update.

Ms. Bolser offered to have her husband volunteer to mow the reservoir and village building a few times until someone could be hired. All agreed this would be fine as he is volunteering his time.

Ms Bolser made a motion to rescind all previous communications regarding the attorney only being able to communicate with the fiscal officer and administrator. Ms. McCoy seconded the motion. Vote 2:1 in favor. Motion carried. Ms. McCoy and Ms. Bolser voted yes, Mr. Ruther voted no.

Continual reports-


Property updates: both were cleaned up for the time being.
