Council Meeting Minutes
August 8th, 2024

Opening:

The regular meeting of the council of the Village of College Corner, Ohio was called to order at 7:00PM on August 8, 2024.

Approval of Minutes/bills:

Emergency ordinance 2024-B was read in full. Ms. Bolser moved to approve, Ms. McCoy seconded the motion. Vote 4:0 in favor, motion carried. ODOT will be notified and they will have the signs installed.

Ms. Cason discussed the upcoming EPA inspection.

Old business:

301 Main is still an ongoing problem, the board of Health and several fire departments are involved due to the open burn issues.

BCSO contract was discussed, they are wanting a \$10,000 increase, council decided to table it at this time.

Fire Contract was presented, Ms. Bolser moved to approve the contract, Ms. McCoy seconded the motion. Vote 4:0 in favor, motion carried.

Ms. McCoy moved to enter executive session pursuant to ORC. 121.22(G) to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or

compensation of a public employee. . Ms. Bolser seconded the motion. Vote 4:0 in favor.
Motion carried. Time entered executive session was 7:25pm.
The regular meeting was reconvened at 7:54pm and all members of council were present.
Council decided to move forward with hiring Mr Leab and Mr. Spenny for part time maintenance.


PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

Adjournment:


